TPC Scottsdale Challenge Day

The Stadium Course at TPC Scottsdale, home of the PGA TOUR's WM Phoenix Open, lies in a manicured desert landscape, with abundant Saguaro cacti and mesquite trees.

The numerous mounds and bunkers contribute to the difficulty of the course, and these combine with the desert areas to create a course of significant strategic challenge.
